Crystal Judson Brame Memorial Scholarship Application Requirements

The Crystal Judson Brame Memorial Scholarship (CJBMS) will be awarded to a student admitted as an undergraduate in an accredited college or university to provide tuition assistance for a one-time payment. Said scholarship is offered with the understanding that all eligibility requirements will be met and maintained during the award period.

Immediate relatives of past and present board members to the Crystal Judson Brame Memorial Scholarship fund are ineligible and MAY NOT apply.

The scholarship recipient will be named no later than June 30, 2008. Scholarship monies will be disbursed to the accredited institution of choice prior to the fall semester of the academic year.

Minimum eligibility requirements:

- ▶ 3.0 G.P.A.
- ▶ Student must attend an accredited college or university within the United States
- ▶ Student must maintain full-time attendance
- ▶ Student must be a graduating senior from Mount Tahoma High School (4634 S 74th St, Tacoma, WA 98409-1004)

Along with the completed scholarship application form, applicant must:

- ▶ Provide a sealed, official high school transcript
- ▶ Submit a FAFSA (Federal Application for Financial Student Aid)—*must be filed*
- ▶ Provide a copy of the Student Aid Report received after filing the FAFSA
- ▶ Obtain three (3) currently-dated letters of reference (two letters from Mount Tahoma High School personnel and one letter from a community member—you select all three individuals)
- ▶ Write a maximum two-page, double-spaced, typed essay explaining why you feel yourself qualified to receive this scholarship.

Selection Process and Announcement

The CJBMS Selection Committee, comprised of selected members of the CJBMS executive board and designated volunteers, will review all applications that are received on or before the deadline date. The Scholarship Selection Committee reserves the right to decline the awarding of the scholarship for any given year.

In arriving at a decision, the Selection Committee will consider an applicant's demonstrated commitment to continuing-education through academic achievement.

To assist in the selection process, the Scholarship Selection Committee may invite applicants to participate in an interview.

The decision of the CJBMS Selection Committee will be final.

The announcement of the scholarship recipient will be made no later than June 30, 2008. However, funds will not be released by the CJBMS foundation to the scholarship recipient until enrollment at the educational institution has been confirmed for the academic year in which the scholarship has been awarded. Funds will be issued directly to the aforementioned institution in one (1) lump sum.
